#### **School Mission**

Osaka International School and Senri International School of Kwansei Gakuin were founded to bring together, for the benefit of returnee, national, and international residents of the Kansai region, the best of Japanese and non-Japanese educational ideas, systems, and techniques into two schools which share a building, programs, curricula, philosophies, experiences, and dreams.

The shared mission of both schools is to educate our students to become "Informed, Caring, Creative Individuals Contributing to a Global Community."

The vision for our schools is revealed in our statements of belief, which apply to all of our schools' divisions, from elementary through grade 12:

#### I. Two Schools Together

- 1. We believe that it is important for the two schools to continually explore ways to come together because this brings great benefit to our students.
- 2. We believe that the closeness of the schools is so important that it is the central part of our vision.

#### II. Exchange of Ideas

- 1. We believe that our schools should be a place where ideas, particularly educational ideas, are freely exchanged among faculty, parents, and students.
- 2. We believe the diversity of experiences of our faculty, parents, and students should be celebrated and the free exchange of ideas will enhance this celebration.

#### III. Understanding of Cultures

- 1. We believe that our schools should be deeply involved in the culture of our host country in study, appreciation, and understanding.
- 2. We believe that our schools should also be involved with the relationship between the culture of Japan and the surrounding cultures of Asia and the rest of the world
- 3. We believe that since our community is composed of so many cultures, our schools should be a place where intercultural understanding is modeled, studied, and celebrated.

#### IV. Learning

- 1. We believe that the special nature of our schools should encourage students to be well-rounded, creative individuals, responsible thinkers and doers, and this is why we believe our programs should be full of choices, special programs, and innovative structures.
- 2. We believe that one of the key responsibilities of our schools is to encourage students to learn how to learn and to carry this kind of learning into adulthood.

#### V. Common Ground

1. We believe that our schools should represent a common ground between Japanese and non-Japanese ideas, practices, beliefs, and traditions.

## Supporting the students

- supporting the school's curriculum philosophy and practice, and understanding that meeting other specific curriculum standards outside of the school's IB curriculum, mission and core values, may not be possible or supported.
- accepting the school's grade level placement of my child(ren), his or her English language and Japanese language level designations, and/or special education needs identification. Please note that there may be additional fees attached to special needs support.
- enriching and support your child(ren)'s home language development as much as possible.

## Supporting the school

- cooperating with teachers and school administrators in support of the progress of your child(ren).
- checking your SOISmail email account regularly and frequently for updates, bulletins, reports and correspondence from the Head of School, or from the school principals, business office, and teachers.
- guaranteeing that your child(ren) will be living with a parent, legal guardian, or in the school dormitory.
- paying all fees as established by the school in accordance with authorized payment plans. Please note that in case of non-payment, the school may restrict students from entering classes, withhold report cards, and/or refuse re-enrollment for the following semester.
- · understanding that the cafeteria services are provided by a contractor that is independent of Osaka International School.
- understanding that the school reserves the right to use and display students' images, videos and voice recordings for a variety of
  purposes, including advertising, marketing and sharing with the community, in accordance with standard international school
  publishing protocols.
- supporting the the school's mission, core values, strategic objectives, programmes, and all initiatives towards their achievement.
- contributing to a positive school environment, avoiding conduct which creates or promotes intolerance or disharmony between and/ or among the school community.
- using established channels of communication when seeking a resolution to a problem or concern; this includes a) starting the conversation with the person(s) directly involved in the issue, then b) contacting the school principal if no resolution can be found by the parties involved. Finally, the Head of School can enter the discussion if still no consensus can be reached.
- volunteering to serve as class representative for at least one academic year during your child(ren)'s enrolment at OIS. Parents with
  more than one child at school may be required to assume the role more than once. Duties may include attending Parent-Teacher
  Association meetings, and/or coordinating class booths for the international fair or school festival.
